The pastors that spoke had several years of experience in planting churches. **We were able to get our trailer to start loading in late June.** The month of July has been filled with the task of getting things packed and loaded. It truly has proven to be a great undertaking.

SPECIAL PRAYER REQUEST

The middle of July, Jonathan was riding his bike and wrecked. We had to take him for treatment in which we found out for sure that he had broken his left arm just above his elbow. He also had a chip on his elbow. They were wondering if surgery would be required. After several X-rays they felt that he would mend properly without the surgery. They put his arm in a cast from his hand almost to his shoulder. He has had several visits to the doctor over the last number of weeks. **Please pray for him** because from the last X-ray it is not healing properly. Our 7 year old daughter, Hannah, was with her grandmother at the grocery store on July 27 pushing a buggy when the cart seat came back and smashed her right thumb. My mother rushed her to the doctor and she received 6 stitches to close her thumb. It not only burst her thumb but it broke it as well. Hannah went to a specialist for further treatment because her primary doctor was concerned that it was not healing as fast as it should. **Please pray for her** that God will touch her hand. Pastor Broyhill and Dr. Gambrell, General Director of FBWWM, have recommended that it would be best to wait until both Jonathan and Hannah have been cleared by the doctor before we move. We are planning to leave as soon as they are released from his care and prayerfully our next letter will be from the state of Washington.
